



## *Political unrest in Honduras*

As most of you know, Honduras has had significant political unrest for the last few weeks that culminated in the previous president being removed from power last weekend. I apologize for getting this information out late, but I have been in Honduras with my family and we had some difficulties getting out of the country. Our location was very safe, but travel was very difficult due to some demonstrations that closed major roads. At the same time, the largest regional airline in Central America canceled all its flights within Honduras due to financial problems. After spending some extra

money and an unexpected 24 hours in Guatemala we made it home safely.

All of our friends and co-workers in Honduras are currently fine. They have had some travel difficulties but these are resolving and they are not in any danger. Please keep them in your prayers as the country works through this current crisis.

For now, we are monitoring the situation closely in Honduras to make sure that we are able to work and move safely in the country. We hope things will settle down in the coming weeks. At this point, trips scheduled

## Nicaragua Update

We are continuing to work together with Iglesia Gran Comision, Managua (the church in Nicaragua) as we slowly move toward providing full time medical care there. We are continuing to use short term medical teams to provide some limited care, become more familiar with the requirements and customs of the country, and to introduce more people to the location.

In late June, a team of 3 doctors, 2 nurses, and 4 non-medical volunteers all spent a week serving there. Over 550 patients, 2 TV interviews, 1 radio interview and 1 newspaper interview later, the team went home exhausted but excited about all that had been done.

To see this project grow, we need new teams who are willing to work
